Often you will find that a worksheet is getting over-complicated and difficult to work with. This session will give you the skills needed to quickly break one, very complex, worksheet into many smaller, and easier to manage, worksheets.

This session will also show you how to view different parts of large worksheets at the same time and how to create cross-worksheet formulas that summarize data from several different worksheets.
